If you do not file and sign your return electronically, please use the peel-off label on the back and place it in the name and address area of your 2005 tax return or Form 8453 or 8453-OL. Correct any incorrect information on the label. Be sure to enter your social security number(s) on your tax return or Form 8453 or 8453-OL.

Last year, over 70 million tax returns were filed electronically with IRS *e-file*. It's the fastest, easiest, and most convenient way to file your income tax return. You may qualify for Free File services, which allow you to use free commercial online tax preparation software to *e-file* your income tax return. Correct any incorrect information on the label. If someone else prepares your return, give the label to your preparer and ask that it be used on your return. To protect your privacy, your social security number(s) (SSN(s)) is not on the label. Be sure to enter your SSN(s) on your tax return or Form 8453 or 8453-OL.

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
